PROLOGUE

The play begins inside an ordinary cottage. It becomes obvious that it is a peasant cottage, and is occupied by a family of four. The NARRATOR appears and begins to tell the story

Narrator: Once there was a land in a time not long ago, where magic tales are often grown And from this magic land comes the tale you'll hear today a fable not well known

> The story here begins with a very special girl A sweet and helpful little lass who works without complaint in the hope she might fit in, But, never could she pass.

For, sometimes things we cannot change Are what we really need And, sometimes things we cannot change Is what helps us succeed

So, as we start our tale in this strange & different land A lesson might be learned today that being who you are and liking what you see Can help you find your way.

(Speaking)

Yes, it's true that beauty is in the eye of the beholder. But in this story it is because of "eyes" that trouble begins. Witness here a mother who had three daughters - each one a bit different from the other.

The youngest was called Little One Eye, because she had only one eye right in the middle of her forehead. The second was called Little Two Eyes, because she had two eyes just like everyone else. And the eldest - her pride and joy was called Little Three Eyes, and her third eye was also right in the middle of her forehead.

Now how, you may ask, is this possible? Well it's quite well known that in the land of magic things are not always the same as they are right here! Why, In many instances people fly on carpets, turn into beautiful Swans and even climb beanstalks to the sky! So, you see, a girl having 3 eyes is really not that unusual.

What <u>is</u> unusual is how a mother could shun her own daughter just because she looks a little "different." For, you see, this mother considers Little One Eye & Little Three Eyes the most beautiful of all girls, but sees Little Two Eyes as nothing more than plain and insignificant. If only she would take the time to see within rather than without!

(Singing) For, sometimes things we cannot change Are what we really need And, sometimes things we cannot change Is what helps us succeed

(Speaking) And so our story begins. It is a typical evening's supper in the household of Little One Eye, Little Two Eyes and Little Three Eyes.

(Singing) So, listen with your heart for the heart will hold the key to finding love and home!

(Little One Eye and Little Three Eyes enter, stealthily making their way over to where Little Two Eyes is asleep)

(They clatte	Little Two Eyes, get up! (2 Eyes begins to stir) Little Two Eyes, get up! (2 Eyes turns over) Little Two Eyes it's for your own good Oh well- ready, Get Set, Go!!! r some pans as Little Two Eyes jumps up in surprise. The tempo a slight more friendly beat)

3 Eyes:	(Hits 1 Eye and corrects her) For you!
1 Eye:	Ah yes, and don't forget that after you have brought that goat to pasture There'll be more things you can <i>see</i> !
3 Eyes:	Do!
	(They help her out of her bed)
3 Eyes:	We didn't want you to forget us while you're gone dear, For that might make you think that we're a <i>mess</i>
1 Eye:	(Hits 3 Eyes and corrects her) That we're not kind!
3 Eyes:	So I have brought some things to mend, <i>(hands her some material)</i> I'm sure before this day will end Your little two eyes will go <i>deaf</i>
1 Eye:	Blind!
Both:	Because, we'll always think of you, yes We'll always think of you When dirty things need tending, we won't say, "That I can do!"

Oh, no, we'll always think of you, yes we're loyal through & through If something here should smell, be sure we'll always think of you!

3 Eyes:	(Spoken) So, put on your apron, and quickly. Mother will be waking soon!
1 Eye:	<i>(Singing)</i> You'd better hurry up along before she wakens For lately, well, it seems she might just cheer
3 Eyes:	She might just crack!
3 Eyes:	And if she finds you started late I'm sure she would not hesitate to give a thrashing to your rear!
1 Eye:	Back!
Both:	Because, we'll always think of you, Goodbye! We'll always think of you Just stay away from here so we don't have to look at you! <i>(Little Two Eyes has left)</i> But, Oh, we'll always think of you, yes we're loyal through & through If something here should smell, be sure we'll always think of you!
1 Eye: 3 Eyes: Both:	Oh yes, we'll always think of you, true we're loyal through & through If fire should befall us Or if hard, hard work should call us Why, We wouldn't dream of sweating before you! Oh, no we'll let you be the first To have that taste of sweat & thirst
1 Eyes: 3 Eyes: 1 Eye: Both:	For we will al-ways Always Always Think of You!

The Prince watches her closely as she reaches up and gently pulls off the most beautiful apple on the tree. He rushes in to take it from her hand.. Mother, Little One Eye & Little Three Eyes watch from a careful distance.

As the last notes are sung, the Little Goat enters and runs over to Little Two Eyes who hugs him tightly. The magical power of love has prevailed!
